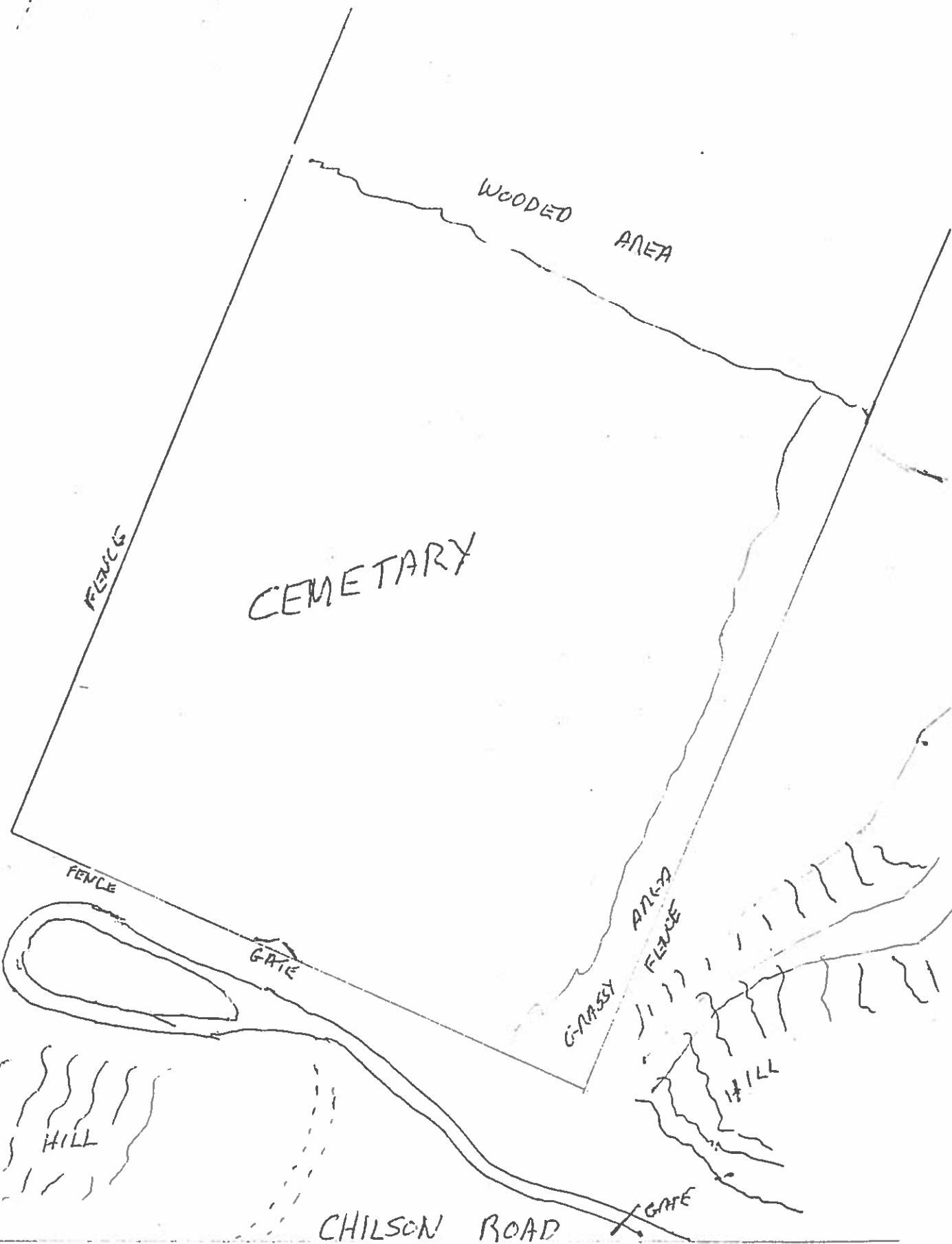


CHILSON Cemetary

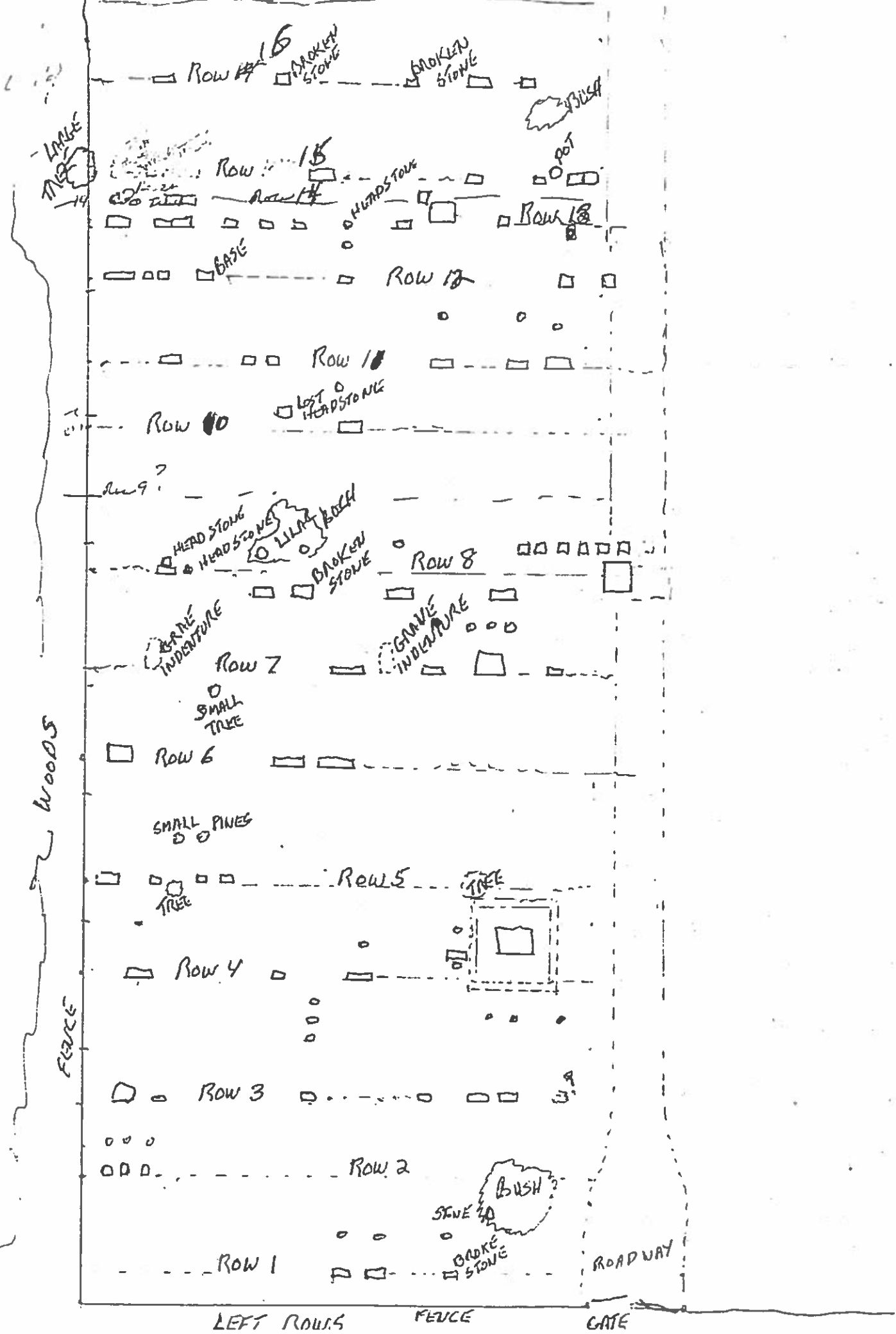
