### Genoa Township Tax Bill information

TAXES ARE DUE: The 2021 Winter Tax Bills were mailed in December to all Genoa Township property owners. **Winter taxes are payable, without penalty, through Feb. 28, 2022.** Please contact the Treasurer's Office at (810) 227-5225 if you did not receive your bill.

The 2021 Summer taxes were billed July 1, 2021 and were payable, without penalty, through Sept. 14. Summer tax payments, plus penalty, can be paid at the Township until Feb. 28, 2022. Please contact the Township, or check [genoa.org](http://genoa.org), for your current amount due.

Payments can be made online by credit card or electronic check, at the township offices by cash or check or by mail to Genoa Township, 2911 Dorr Road, Brighton, MI 48116.

By law, the Township cannot accept 2021 tax payments after Feb. 28, 2022. After that date, taxes are payable at the Livingston County Treasurer's Office, 200 E. Grand River, Howell. Call the County Treasurer's Office at (517) 546-2440 if you have questions.
