### The Genoa Township 2022 Draft Master Plan

The Township is now accepting public comments on the draft 2022 Master Plan. In accordance with Section 125.3841 of Public Act 33 of 2008 (Michigan Planning Enabling Act), the draft Master Plan is being made available to surrounding communities and other respondents for 63 days to review and provide comments on the plan.

The 63-day comment period will run from June 27th, 2022 through August 29, 2022. The plan is available for download [here](#). If this online version of the draft document is insufficient for review, a printed copy can be provided upon request.

### 2022 Summer Tax Information

The 2022 Summer tax amounts were officially levied on July 1st. Summer taxes are payable, without penalty, through Wednesday, September 14, 2022.

The 2022 Summer Tax Bills were mailed to all Genoa Township property owners on Thursday, June 30, 2022.

## Genoa Township 2022 Road Projects

### **Crooked Lake Road Update**

The Livingston County Road Commission work on approximately 2.05 miles Crooked Lake Road between Latson Road and Dorr Road continues through July 1, weather permitting.

Crooked Lake Road will be paved from Fishbeck Road through the Latson Road intersection and resurfaced from Fishbeck to Dorr roads.

Crooked Lake Road will be CLOSED to traffic during construction. Access to the residential homes will be maintained. **Access to the school will be maintained from Latson Rd while school is in session. Please visit [genoa.org](http://genoa.org) for the official detour route.**

### **Hacker Road Construction**

Construction on Hacker Road from Clark Lake Road to Golf Club Road is set to begin this Tuesday (July 5, 2022).

The Livingston County Road Commission will be working on the pavement and shoulders along this stretch. Two-way traffic will be maintained with flag control but there will be major impact on traffic.

This project is expected to continue through July 14.
