Welcome to this month's edition of Genoa Township news via email. Here's what's coming up in the Township:

2023 Summer Taxes

The 2023 Summer Tax Bills were mailed to all Genoa Township property owners on Friday, June 30th. Summer taxes are payable, without penalty, July 1st through September 14th. Please contact the Treasurer's Office at (810) 227-5225 if you did not receive your bill.

Extra Trash Item Frequently Asked Questions

- Waste Management will take one bulk item from every household every week.
- These are items that do not fit in your garbage cart. Examples include furniture, TVs, washing machines, etc.
- Excess garbage bags or recycling is not bulk. If you have excess household trash or recycling you can contact Waste Management to pay for an additional pick up. You can also contract directly with Waste Management for additional weekly service if needed. You can sign up for and pay for this service by calling (810) 201-5576. When they ask for your account number put in your zip code. Then follow the prompts to speak with a WM customer service rep.
- All mattresses, upholstered furniture and fabric items must be completely wrapped in plastic.
- Bulk should be placed out the night before your collection day, about 3 feet from your garbage cart.
- Bulk items are collected by a special truck and must stay at the curb. Collection can take up to a week. If no pickup after a week, call the Township. We will contact WM on your behalf.
