Tax Information

The 2024 Winter taxes were mailed out to all property owners on Wednesday, November 27, 2024, and are payable through February 28, 2025. Please contact the Treasurer's office if you do not receive your bill.

The Big Red Barrel

Addiction typically starts with prescription medication abuse, specifically heavy pain killers. After numerous deaths throughout Livingston County that were attributed to drug overdoses, Livingston County Community Alliance members (LCCA) saw the need for a place where people could safely dispose of their unwanted medication. The Big Red Barrel effort has resulted in the secure and environmentally safe disposal of over 30 tons (or 60,000 pounds) of drugs. With permanent prescription drug collection units available for community use, it would decrease the likelihood of prescription drug abuse, heroin use, and maintain a healthy environment.

Pills, Capsules, and Tablets

- Bring pills or vitamins(prescriptions from doctors or vets, over the counter medications) in their
 original containers and a resealable plastic baggie to any Big Red Barrel location.
- Remove pills from their original container and place them into the baggie.

Seal the baggie and dispose of it into the barrel. *If you don't have a baggie, please dump the pills directly into the barrel.

<u>Liquid Medication, Ointments, Lotions</u> • Prior to disposal, absorb the liquid with a paper towel.

 Place the soaked paper towel into a resealable plastic baggie. Make sure you have the empty bottle on-hand to ensure compliance with federal laws.

Dispose of the resealable plastic bag into the Big Red Barrel. It is your responsibility to dispose of the empty bottle somewhere other than the Big Red Barrel.


Needles and Syringes

Red Barrel now accept syringes/needles in partnership with the Livingston County Drain Commissioner at local events and on the 1st Saturday of each month at Recycle Livingston, 9:00am-1:00pm.

Put syringes/needles in a sharps container or an empty detergent bottle. Duct tape the top of the detergent bottle to prevent from opening. For additional information about proper needle disposal, you can also visit the Livingston County website.


2025 Township Meeting Schedule

Each year the Township Board approves the meeting schedule for the Board of Trustees. Planning Commission, and Zoning Board of Appeals. Unless capacity concerns require special location, meetings will be held at 6:30 p.m. at the Genoa Township Hall located at 2911 Dorr Road. Regular meetings of the Township Board are generally scheduled for the first and third Monday of every month. The Planning Commission generally meets the second and if necessary, the fourth Monday; and the Zoning Board of Appeals usually meets the third Tuesday of each month. Winter Sledding at the Township Park

When snow is in the forecast come enjoy the fresh snowfall at the Genoa Township sled hill!

The sled hill has a vertical drop of approximately 40-feet and a run length of over 200 feet and is fun for all ages.

Benches have been installed at the top for parents and those waiting to sled. There are heated bathrooms and a warming area at the Township Park Pavilion. There is a parking lot across the Township driveway from the sled hill where parents can sit and watch their sledders in the comfort of their vehicles. Last but not least, a light pole has been installed at the hill allows night time sledding.

All are welcome to enjoy the winter fun for free at the Township sledding hill.

Livingston County Veterans Services

Livingston County Veteran Services (LCVS) offers a variety of programs and services to assist veterans and their families. LCVS employs nationally accredited Veteran Service Officers to assist veterans in filing for US Dept. of Veterans Affairs benefits. Honorably Discharged veterans registered with LCVS, and their spouse may utilize complimentary LCVS transportation to medical appointments within a 50-mile radius. To schedule a ride, call LETS at (517) 546-6600, select option 3 and mention veteran status. LCVS offers Honorably Discharged veterans who are less fortunate several assistance programs provided by Emergency Relief funds, such as:

- · \$200 food and toiletry voucher plus an additional \$50 for each child in the household,
- \$200 clothing vouchers for their school-aged children up to age 18,
- · \$50 Speedway fuel only cards; and
- · Dental assistance of up to \$1,000 via LCVS partnership with VINA Dental.

Call (517) 546-6338 to set up an appointment and qualify for these programs.

Bulk Item FAQ

- Waste Management will take one bulk item from every household every week.
- These are items that do not fit in your garbage cart. Examples furniture, TVs, washing machines, etc.
- Excess garbage bags or recycling is not bulk.
- Fabric items must be completely wrapped in plastic.
- Bulk should be placed out the night before your collection day, about 3 feet from your garbage cart.
- Bulk items are collected by a special truck and must stay at the curb. Collection can take

up to five business days. If no pickup after five days, call the Township. We will contact WM on your behalf.

- Yard waste is not bulk and cannot be put into your regular trash or recycling. Contact Waste Management at (810) 201-5576 with yard waste questions.
- Waste Management will collect live Christmas trees for the three weeks following the holiday. Trees should be placed curbside, cut into segments of six feet or less, free of decorations and un-bagged.

 Legacy Hills – Residential Planned Unit Development (RPUD), 127.57 acres of vacant land located at the northwest corner of Challis Road and Bauer Road, Brighton: Request for PUD rezoning from Agricultural to Low-Density Residential Planned Unit Development (LDR/RPUD), conceptual PUD Plan and related materials for a proposed 55 unit clustered single family residential development. This item was postponed at the December 4, 2024 meeting and the developer has revised the plan to reduce the number of the lots.
