Know all men by these Presents, that Orrin Case and Amette Case, his wife and Robt. E. Long, Engineer, have caused this plat of the Village of HILSON to be laid out and approved by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Livingston, Michigan, by the act of the Legislature approved May 27, 1886. The land included in this plat is a part of the South East Quarter of the South West Section of section 28 Township 2 North of Range 5 East Michigan to West Beginning at the quarter post between sections 28 and 33 in range 5, namely 2.61 North of Range 5 East Michigan, thence bearing West 247.05 feet on the section line thence running North 70° 36' West 14.43 feet to the East and West Eight Pole thence East along said eighth line 100.59 feet thence South 27° 53' East 337.77 feet thence North 40° 24' East 18.5 feet thence South 15° 31' East 583.6 feet thence South 29.44 feet to the place of beginning. All measurements are expressed in feet and decimal parts. One of Case's put down Street, Long Street and one block of 20 feet in width is also laid out on the easterly side of Block C as shown by this plat and also an alley or nearly dedicated for public use, Brighton Road is an established legal highway 60 feet wide. Blocks are designated by letters from A to G, inclusive, and lot numbers figured placed at or near their center.

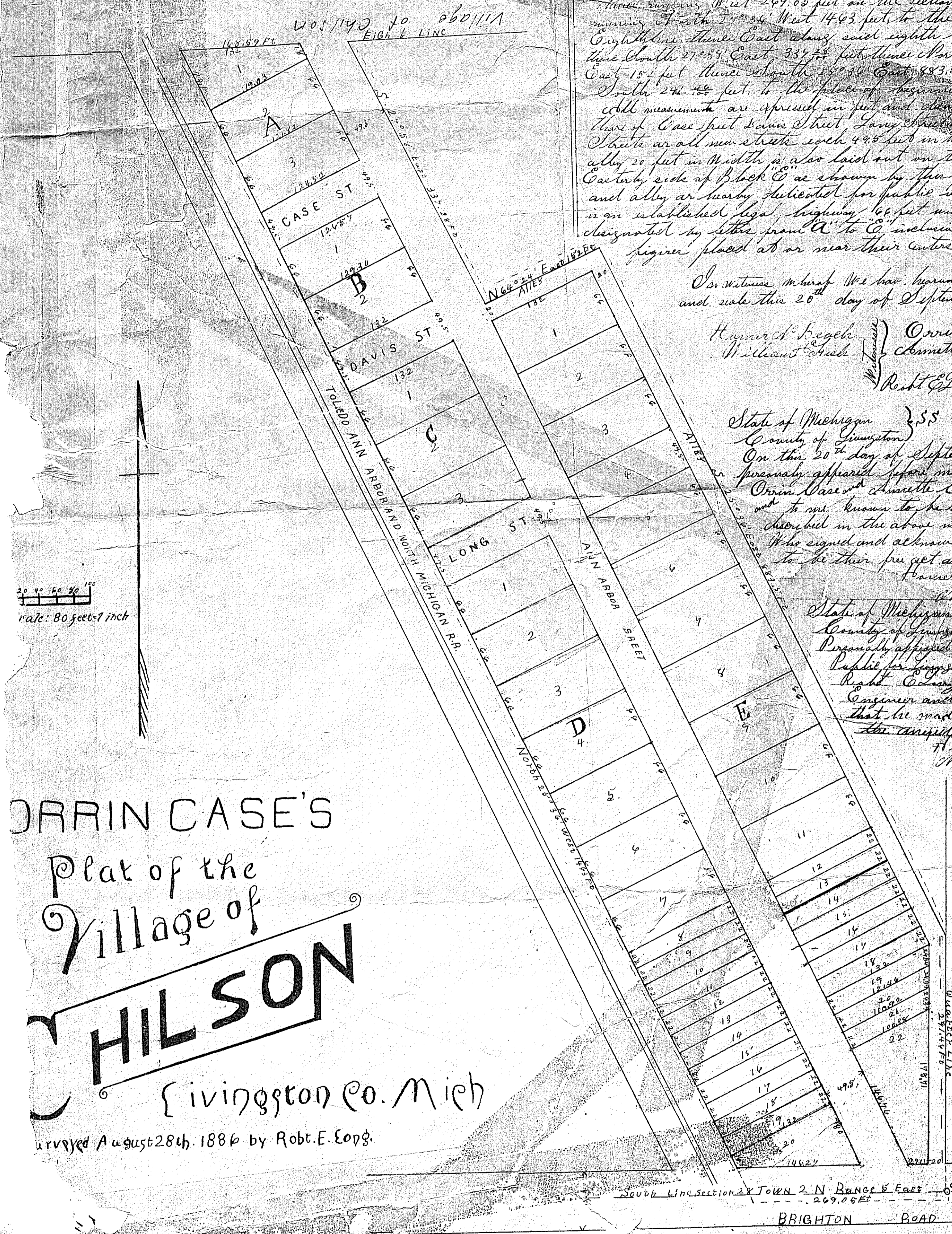
