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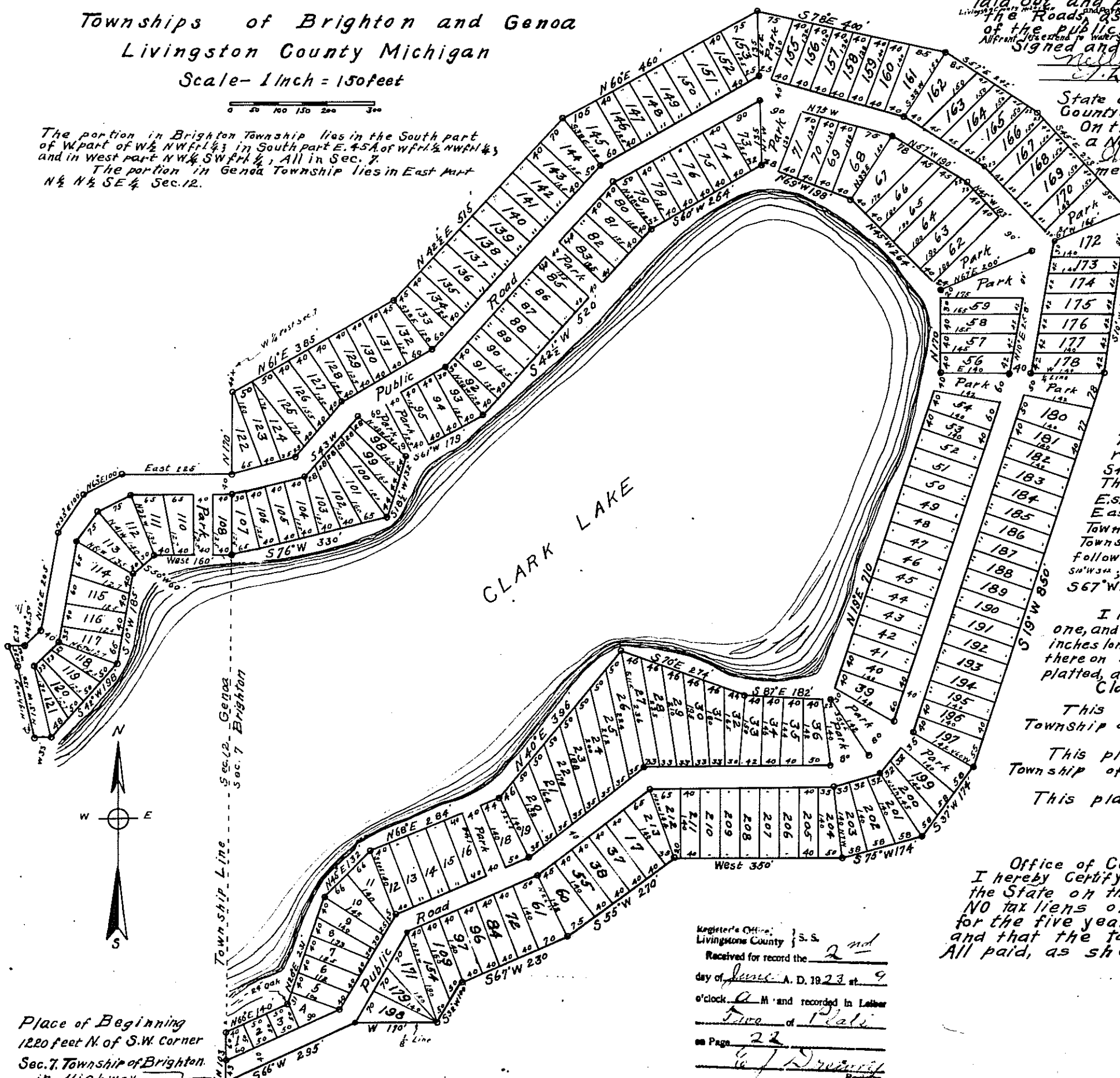
PLAT OF CLARK LAKE PARK

DESCRIPTION - The land embraced in the annexed Plat of Clark Lake Park is described as follows:
Beginning at a point 1220 feet N. of S.W. Corner Sec. 7, on West line of Township of Brighton, Town 2 N of Range 6 E Mich. Running thence as follows: N 103° N 66° E 140', N 20° E 231', N 45° E 132', N 68° E 284', N 40° E 396', S 70° E 274', S 87° E 182', N 19° E 710', N 170', N 45° W 264', N 69° W 198', S 60° W 264', S 42° W 520', S 61° W 179', S 18° W 132', S 75° W 330', to West town line at a point 375' S of W 1/4 post Sec. 7 Township of Brighton. Here entering the Township of Genoa, Town 2 N of Range 5 E Michigan, on Sec. 12 running thence as follows: West 160', S 50° W 60', S 10° W 185', S 42° W 198', to E. side of Highway, thence West 33' to center of Highway. Thence N 13° W 150' along Highway, N 25° W 45' in Highway, East 33' to E. side of Highway, Thence N 45° E 50', N 10° E 205', N 35° E 100', N 63° E 100', East 225', to E. line of Sec. 12 Township of Genoa. Thence N. along the Town line 170' and here leaving Genoa Township, and entering the Township of Brighton at a point 40' S of W 1/4 post Sec. 7. Running thence as follows: N 61° E 385', N 42° E 515', N 60° E 460', S 78° E 400', S 51° E 241', S 47° E 225', S 19° W 850', S 37° W 174', S 75° W 174', West 350', S 55° W 270', S 67° W 230', S 32° W 100', West 170' along line, S 66° W 295' to place of beginning.
