Supervisor McCririe called the regular meeting of the Genoa Charter Township Board to order at 6:30 p.m. The Pledge of Allegiance was then said. The following board members were present constituting a quorum for the transaction of business: Gary McCririe, Paulette Skolarus, Robin Hunt, Todd Smith, Jim Mortensen and Jean Ledford. Also present were Township Manager Michael Archinal, Township Attorney Frank Mancuso and five persons in the audience. Call to Order:

A Call to the Public was made with no response.

Approval of Consent Agenda:

Moved by Smith and supported by Mortensen to approve all items listed under the Consent Agenda as requested. The motion carried unanimously.

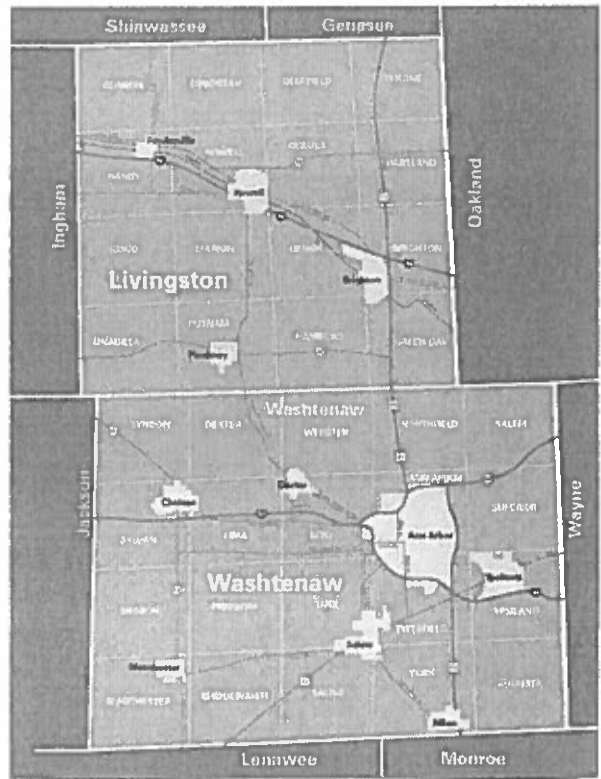

Attached please find a Memo from Tetra Tech, dated April 30, 2014, entitled “*Genoa Township Sanitary Sewer and Water Main Connection Fee Analysis*” which evaluated the connection fees for the MHOG (Marion Howell Oceola Genoa) Water System and the GO (Genoa Oceola) Sanitary Sewer System in Genoa Township. In general, these municipal systems currently serve the Grand River corridor and the adjacent subdivisions near Grand River in Genoa Township.

We are seeing an increase in development in this area, and we expect this trend to continue due to the recently constructed Latson Road Interchange. All future growth that connects to our municipal water and sanitary sewer systems must be carefully evaluated to ensure we are fiscally prepared to perform the necessary improvements to accommodate the growth.

The connection fee recommendations are based on an evaluation of the cost to “buy in” to the existing system capacity and the necessary capital improvements to serve future growth. It should be noted that for the GO Sanitary Sewer System the cost of providing service north of the highway, where there is currently infrastructure, was much lower than serving the area of south of the highway. Therefore, the recommended connection fee for the GO Sanitary Sewer System is split into two areas, north and south of the highway.

Staff concurs with the recommendation in Section 4.0 – Conclusions – of the April 30th Memo, and as such we ask the Genoa Township Board to consider the following motion:

1.0 SUMMARY

Genoa Township is anticipating new development in the South Latson area in connection with the completion of the Latson Road interchange. In order to plan for future utility demands, Tetra Tech prepared the October 2013 "South Latson Road Service Area Water Distribution and Sanitary Sewer Collection System Report". The report analyzed the potential for development in the area and summarized a list of capital improvements required within the system to provide utility service to these properties. In order to ensure that the Township is able to support future development and provide utility service, the Township requested that Tetra Tech perform an analysis of the current sanitary sewer and water main system connection fees, and determine if changes to these fees were necessary.

2.0 APPROACH

Sewer and water customer capital connection fees should be based on mathematical formulas designed to comply with guidance for valid user fees included in the December 1998 Michigan Supreme Court decision in the case of *Bolt v. City of Lansing*. The connection fees for sanitary sewer and water were evaluated individually, as water service is provided by the Marion, Howell, Oceola & Genoa (MHOG) Water Treatment Plant and sanitary sewer service is provided by the Genoa-Oceola (G-O) Wastewater Treatment Plant, and each have different potential service areas and capital improvement needs.

The new fees will consist of two components: a system capacity cost and a capital improvement cost. Both the MHOG WTP and G-O WWTP and corresponding distribution and collection systems were constructed through existing user connection fees and special assessments.

- Capacity Cost - To calculate a cost associated with these new developments "buying in" to the existing system capacity, a cost per residential equivalent user (REU) was developed based on the initial bond costs to construct the treatment plants and subsequent improvements, and then dividing that total cost by the existing plant capacity.
- Capital Improvement Cost – The specific capital improvements as noted in the S. Latson Road Service Area Report were used to generate total capital improvement costs. It was noted that in some areas certain improvements are not necessary to provide utility service, so including all improvements in a

2.1.2 Capital Improvement Cost - Water

In the October 2013 report, there were thirteen (13) improvements recommended to upgrade the water system to service this area which totaled \$10.77 million. Tables 3 lists the costs associated with each of the improvements along with a total cost per REU in the service district.

PROJECT AGREEMENT

This Agreement made and entered into this _____ day of _____, 2014, by and between GENOA Township, Livingston County, Michigan, hereinafter referred to as "TOWNSHIP" and the BOARD OF COUNTY ROAD COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF LIVINGSTON, hereinafter referred to as "ROAD COMMISSION."

WITNESSETH

The Township has selected the following roads to be improved as described below:

**CROOKED LAKE ROAD
(CHILSON ROAD TO FISHBECK ROAD)
APPROXIMATELY 7,050 FEET
SURFACE LIMESTONE, TREE WORK,
AND LIMITED DRAINAGE WORK,
ALTOGETHER WITH THE NECESSARY RELATED WORK**

The parties agree as follows:

1. The Township shall pay the Road Commission the cost of the project, as follows: **\$200,000**.
 - A. This contract shall not exceed One Hundred Ten Percent (110%) of the total project cost without prior consultation with the Township.
 - B. The balance shall be paid as invoiced. If an invoice is not paid within 45 days of billing, the Township will pay ten per cent (10%) annual interest on that billed but unpaid.
 - C. The Road Commission shall furnish the Township with a final breakdown of its actual expenses upon completion of the project which will include fringe benefits, rentals, and subcontract charges. It is the intention of the parties that one hundred per cent (100%) of the Road Commission's direct contract costs will be paid by the Township.
 - D. The Road Commission shall furnish the Township with a final breakdown of its actual expenses upon completion of the project which will include fringe benefits, overhead, rentals, and subcontract charges. It is the intention of the parties that all of the Road Commission costs, except its administration, will be paid by the Township.
 - E. The Township will not withhold payments because of any set-off, counterclaim, or any other claim which it may have against the Road Commission arising out of this or any other matter. If there is a dispute over the balance due upon completion, the Township will pay the amount claimed by the Road Commission, and such payment shall not be a waiver by the Township of any claims it may have arising from this contract and the completion of the project.
2. All work shall be performed in a good workmanlike manner and in accordance with plans and specifications adopted by the Road Commission.
3. The Road Commission shall hold the Township harmless from any liability arising from the work performed pursuant to this contract.

4. The work will be completed within the current contract year, unless the parties otherwise so agree. In the event the Road Commission is unable to complete the work by the time specified, any funds prepaid by the Township shall be returned to it, or the Road Commission shall pay ten per cent (10%) annual interest on the funds retained. All funds returned to the Township shall be repaid to the Road Commission as invoiced.
5. In the event the project cannot be completed due to circumstances beyond the control of the Road Commission, and through no fault of the Road Commission, the contract price for later completion will be subject to renegotiation.

As you know, at our last SELCRA Board meeting on Wednesday, June 11, 2014, the SELCRA Board of Directors voted unanimously to raise the per-participant municipal annual contribution rate from \$23 to \$27. As stated in the SELCRA under Financing the Authority Section A. (1) "The Authority may increase or decrease the current \$23.00 per participant charge set forth above by obtaining the consent of all the participating municipalities."

As discussed at the board meeting, under my four years of leadership at SELCRA we have worked very hard on cost recovery and operating as fiscally responsible as possible. In doing so we have been recognized for our success in maintaining excellent service at a low cost to both the township and to the residents of the *Brighton Region*. However, we can no longer maintain our current level of high quality/low cost services with the same contribution amount. From the year 2000, the State of Michigan Cost-of-Living Adjustment rate on \$150,000 (yearly municipal contributions to SLECRA) has risen to \$206,000 (\$56k increase) in 2014. Over that same period SELCRA's \$150,000 contribution level has stayed the same or been substantially lower. The increase to \$27 will cover the negative \$20k budget deficit for the upcoming year and is merely a short-term remedy. Inflation on goods and services including the cost of healthcare for our employees will continue to be long-term financial issues that will need to be addressed. I can assure you that we are exploring all of our options to keep SELCRA a fiscally responsible and competitive authority for both the residents and our professional team.

Enclosed you will find (1) a comparison of SELCRA Municipality Contributions and Percentages from 2000 – 2014; (2) a new spreadsheet identifying your municipality's participation including the new rate; (3) an invoice for the SELCRA 2014/15 fiscal period.
