



## Seasonal FAQs

### Yard Waste Collection

Collection begins the first Friday of April and runs through the 1st week of December. There is a \$10 charge for up to 10 bags or bundles and extra reserved at the rate of \$1 per bag or bundle above 10. During the yard waste season, GFL Environmental will collect all properly prepared yard waste on the 1<sup>st</sup> Friday of the month. You must call in the Monday before your yard waste collection day to be serviced that Friday.

- ***How to best dispose of yard waste?***  
Yard waste is defined as leaves, lawn cuttings, and shrub and tree trimmings and the like. Place into biodegradable bags or containers of 35 gallons or less. No Plastic bags of any kind can be used. We enforce a weight limit of 50 pounds. Brush and limbs greater than 2 inches in diameter must be in bundles not longer than 4 feet in length, and not exceeding a total of 18 inches in diameter, or more than 50 pounds. If you wish to use your own 35 gallon can Call GFL Environmental to get a "Compost" sticker
- ***What does NOT qualify as yard waste?***  
Dirt, sod, large stumps, sand, gravel, concrete, rocks, animal feces and dead animals.

### Holiday Collection

- ***Holiday Services***  
We are closed on the following holidays during yard waste season **Memorial Day, Fourth of July, Labor Day, and Thanksgiving Day**. If your pickup day falls on or after a holiday during the business week, services will be pushed back one day i.e. Friday pickup will be changed to Saturday.
- ***Christmas trees***  
Christmas trees will be considered yard waste unless they have Lights, Ornaments, or Decorations then they are considered trash.
