The Big Red Barrel is a drug take back program that the Township will sponsor on January 26th and April 27th of 2019 from 10:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m. simply bring a plastic bag filled with all your outdated and/or unused medication. Please don't bring your pill containers. We do not require identification and there is no cost to you.

ASK YOURSELF THE FOLLOWING QUESTIONS:

- Is your home safe?
- Do you have outdated prescription drugs or needles in your medicine cabinet?
- Did you know that Livingston County children use alcohol and drugs at a rate higher than the national average?
- Did you know that prescription and over-the-counter drugs account for the top illicit drugs abused by high school seniors in the past year?
- Did you know that Heroin addiction typically starts with the abuse of prescription medications such as **painkillers found in the home**?
- Did you know that the chemical contained in prescription drugs enter the environment by putting them down the drain?
- Did you know that putting your drugs down the drain will ultimately impact aquatic life?
- Did you know your drinking water may be impacted by putting them down the drain?
